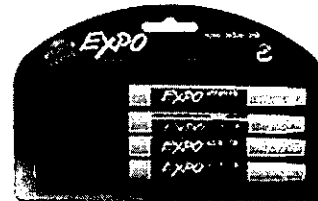

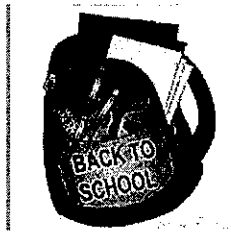

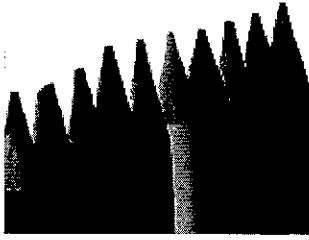

- last name N-Z: sandwich-size sealable bags

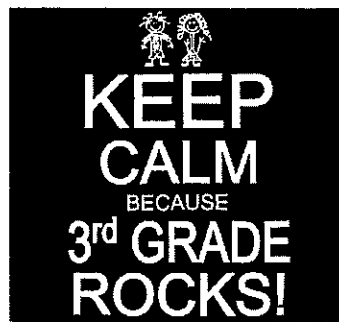
