



William Floyd High School offers a driver education program to eligible William Floyd students. In order to be eligible the student must be at least 16 years old and be in possession of a valid learner's permit or junior license. **All students are chosen by date of birth** not "first-come, first served". Students will attend class for a total of three (3) hours per week (90 minutes of lecture, 90 minutes in car). **Students must attend every scheduled session in order to meet the attendance requirements as mandated by the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles, in cooperation with the NYS Department of Education.** It is the student's responsibility to notify the driver education office to arrange make up class. Any student with three (3) or more absences with makeups will be dropped. Upon successful completion of the course the student will be issued a certificate of completion (MV-285). The MV-285 is needed for students to obtain a class D license on the students 17th birthday, along with a reduction in car insurance.

The completed application and consent form must be signed by a parent/guardian. A parent/ guardian signature acknowledges that the student/parent/guardian is aware of the attendance requirements and responsibilities.

Please return the application only and consent form (no checks) to the driver education office in William Floyd District Office (240 Mastic Beach Road, Mastic Beach, NY 11951) by 01/15/2019. Applications can be mailed or dropped off (8am – 12pm) in District Office or faxed to (631) 874-1847, but **MUST** be received by 01/15/2019 to be considered.

Selected students will receive a letter in the mail or an email letting them know if they have been selected. **Selected students will need to submit a check/money order/cash for \$400 along with a clear copy of their learners permit/license, to the driver education office (8am to 3:30pm) by January 24, 2019.**

Once the course begins there will be no refunds issued.

Students participating in sports will not be permitted to miss schedule class for games or practices.

Spring classes are schedule to begin February 1, 2019 and completed the week of June 14, 2019. Classes cancelled due to weather conditions may extend the session as needed. All students must complete all required lectures and drives to receive the DMV MV-285 completion certificate.

PARENT/STUDENT CONSENT FORM

Rules and Regulations:

1. Driver education is an extra-curricular activity designed to nurture and develop a sense of responsibility in the student. It is therefore the obligation of the student to maintain the following
 - Individual attendance
 - Submission of lecture work in a timely fashion
 - Mature, responsible and appropriate behavior in lecture class and in-car instruction

Students will be notified when obligations are not met. They may also be removed from the program for unacceptable behavior. **Once the program begins there will be no refunds given.**

2. Absences: **Only one (1) absence per session will be allowed. Students must arrange for a makeup class.** *No refund will be issued for non-attendance.* Parents/students please be aware of the scheduled driver education classes and arrange vacation, sports and work hours accordingly. If date conflicts are evident you should not enroll.
3. Students must wear proper shoes or sneakers, flip-flops are not allowed.
4. Students spend approximately 15 to 20 minutes behind the wheel at each session. Parents are encouraged to drive one to two hours per week with their child to supplement their driving experience.

William Floyd High School offers a driver education program to eligible William Floyd students. In order to be eligible, a student must be 16 years old and be in possession of a valid learner's permit or junior license. Seniors will be scheduled first. All students are chosen by date of birth not "first-come first-served". The maximum students for the program are limited to 80. Students will attend class for a total of three (3) hours per week; which includes 90 minutes of lecture and 90 minutes of in car instruction each assigned day. Students must attend every scheduled session in order to meet the attendance requirements as mandated by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles, in cooperation with the New York State Education Department. Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be issued a certificate of completion (MV_285). The MV-285 certificate is needed for a student obtain a class D license on the student's 17th birthday, along with an auto insurance discount.

We have three (3) sessions; fall, spring and summer. Applications are available online at www.wfsd.k12.ny.us, under Students, then Driver Education.

Applications for the Spring session are due in District Office by 01/15/2019

Completed driver education applications need to be dropped off (between 8am – 3:30pm), **received** by mail in District Office or faxed to (631)874-1847 by 01/15/2019. Students will be notified by letter or email if they have been accepted into the program. Applications are not kept on file; in the event that the student is placed on the waitlist, a new application must be submitted for each semester in which they are applying. A fee of \$400 and a clear copy of a learners permit will be due at the specified time in the acceptance letter.
