TYPICAL DUTIES:

Install, maintain, and repair electrical equipment in accordance with state, local, and federal codes, and regulations. Performs basic maintenance tasks including but not limited to carpentry, lighting, plumbing, and mechanical systems. Operates district emergency backup generators monthly and maintains records of each. Maintains inventory of common parts and supplies and replaces stock as necessary. Utilizes work request system to review current work requests and update status as necessary. Assists in snow response and removal as required. Does related work as required.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Thorough knowledge of the practices, materials, tools and methods maintenance and repair of Electrical systems. Thorough understanding of State, Federal, and local electrical codes and regulations, thorough knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions of various mechanical and electrical work. Skill in the use and care of tools, materials, and equipment necessary for the operation and maintenance of electrical systems. Ability to understand and work from general instructions.
