## **CAMP REQUIREMENTS**

- Open to school district residents and non-residents.
- Non-residents must submit a current physical at the time of registration.
- ALL students must have a current physical from a medical doctor on file with the school district in order to participate.
- All payments must be submitted along with a completed enrollment form to the <u>WFHS Athletic Office.</u>
- All medications must be signed in with the trainer on the first day of camp.
- Refunds will only be provided for medical reasons. Requests must be in writing and must include a physician's note.

# All camps will follow and meet New York State Department of Health and NYSPHSAA recommendations for COVID-19:

- Health surveys must be filled out before camp starts each day.
- Temperature checks will occur at the beginning of each day.
- Coaches will keep strict attendance records.
- Coaches and students will follow NYSDOH and NYSPHSAA guidelines.
