AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO ALL WILLIAM FLOYD SCHOOL DISTRICT RESIDENTS

Dear Resident.

Our District was notified by the Suffolk County Police Department that the following sex offender is residing in the Shirley area. This information is provided to you in accordance with New York State Correction Law, Article 6c, of the Sex Offender Registration Act:

-Level 1 Offender (Low Risk) – The individual is a white male named Jeremy Tierney (Aliases: Jeremy Soganks-Tierney; JT Tierney) who resides in Shirley, NY (addresses for Level I offenders are not available). His date of birth is 9/3/1985.

This information is intended to inform you, not unduly alarm you. Please use this information as an opportunity to review personal safety issues with your family. If you are unsure of what to discuss with your child and family, please feel free to email your questions at SOinfo@wfsd.k12.ny.us.

Please be aware that a detailed description is automatically given to each staff member and bus driver. Additional information about this specific matter can be obtained from the William Floyd School District Office located at 240 Mastic Beach Road, Mastic Beach.
